We have decided to celebrate this momentous occasion with a traditional English Afternoon Tea at Barnes Close concluding with a short time of Thanksgiving Worship.

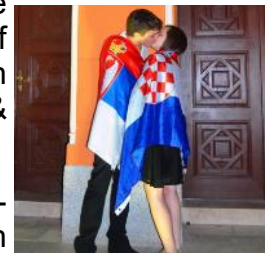
